

Signing of Letter of Intent (LoI) between NABARD and UNEP

NABARD signed a Letter of Intent (LoI) with United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) on 07 March 2017, in the presence of Mr Erik Solheim Executive Director, UNEP and Shri H.R. Dave, Deputy Managing Director, NABARD and other privileged dignitaries from both the organisations.

Speaking on the occasion Mr Erik Solheim indicated that the partnership would be of immense value in terms of working in the areas of water conservation & management, energy access for rural areas through renewable energy, climate resilient agriculture practices, scaling up adaptation, tools based on best practices at global level for promoting sustainable development and building climate change resilience.

Shri H.R. Dave, Deputy Managing Director expressed his intent to work closely with UNEP in the area of sustainable development, conservation and management of natural resources, green financing and building up of climate change resilience as the people's moment.

The LoI was signed by Shri H.R. Dave, Deputy Managing Director representing NABARD and Mr Erik Solheim, Executive Director, UNEP. The LoI with UNEP envisages collaboration in areas of Natural Resources Management, solar electrification, crop residue management, social sectors like drinking water and sanitation etc., leveraging the strengths of each partnering institutions. The partnership is envisioned to mainstream environmental and climate change resilience building activities into developmental planning through carrying out various training and capacity building indicatives, knowledge management, fostering south-south cooperation, and other issues of common interest between NABARD and UNEP.
