

“Scaling Climate Smart Agriculture through Mainstreaming Climate Smart Villages in Bihar”

The project aims to promote conservation agriculture based management practices (zero tillage, direct seeded rice, residue management), cropping system optimization/diversification, decision support (nutrition expert) and sensor (green seekers) based site specific nutrient management, precision water management (laser levelling), stress resilient cultivars, capacity building, knowledge and experience dissemination to wider population. The project is being implemented in the 100 villages in 04 corridors, viz., Samastipur-Darbhanga, Katihar – Purnea, Bihar Sharif- Patna and Bhagalpur- Munger of Bihar. The project is expected to benefit 70 project villages in the Banswara District. The project is executed by Department of Agriculture, Government of Bihar with a NAFCC grant assistance of Rs. 23.06 Crore.
