Building Adaptive Capacities of Small Inland Fishermen Community for Climate Resilience and Livelihood Security" is being executed by agency TAAL in Gandhwani (tribal) block of Dhar district in Madhya Pradesh. The project will lead to increase in water retention capacity of the tanks as an adaptive measure to address rainfall variability by modifying technical specification of the tanks, diversification of fish species and temperature regulation of ponds, climate resilient small pond fisheries through productivity enhancement by capacity building and institutional linkages and preparation and dissemination of evidence based resilient climate change adaptation strategies for inland fisheries for small pond fishers throughout the country.
