

“Climate smart actions and strategies in North Western Himalayan region for sustainable livelihoods of agriculture-dependent hill communities”: The proposed project seeks to improve the adaptive capacity of vulnerable communities in the North Western Himalayan hill region by introducing a combination of climate smart farming technologies covering crops, livestock and water resources, and by undertaking community strengthening processes and capacity building actions. The project is being executed by BAIF with an outlay of USD 0.969 million in 10 villages in Champawat district of Uttarakhand.
