"Climate Change Adaptation for Natural Resource Dependent Communities in Kachchh, Gujarat"

The project aims to enhance the adaptive capacity of natural resource dependent communities (Agriculture, Coastal Fishing and Pastoral communities) to climate change in targeted villages of Kachchh district, Gujarat. The project is being implemented in 32 villages of 3 talukas viz., Bachua taluka, Abdasa taluka and Bhuj Taluka of Kachchh district. The project would benefit around 1230 households from agricultural zone, 700 households from coastal zone and 240 households from pastoral zone totalling 2170 households (at least 35% of women as beneficiaries). Gujarat Ecological Education and Research (GEER) Foundation is executing the project with an outlay of Rs. 21.36 Crores.
