## "Ecosystem Services based Adaptation to Climate Change in Bundelkhand Region of Uttar Pradesh"

The project aims to undertake baseline surveys for assessing climatic vulnerability of the project area, undertake JFMC Plantation in 732 ha. area, distribute about 15,000 plants per village covering 30 ha. area. Community based restoration of degraded forest areas would be done to bring 800 ha of agricultural area under drip irrigation, live hedge fencing, spring development, fodder storage, publication of resource materials, etc. Project would be implemented in Banda, Hamirpur, Orai (Jalaun) & Chitrakoot Districts in the Bundelkhand region of Uttar Pradesh. The project is expected to benefit 16 Villages/Joint Forest Committees of the Project Locations. The project is being executed by Forest and Wildlife Department, Government of Uttar Pradesh with a NAFCC grant assistance of Rs. 20.02 Crore.
