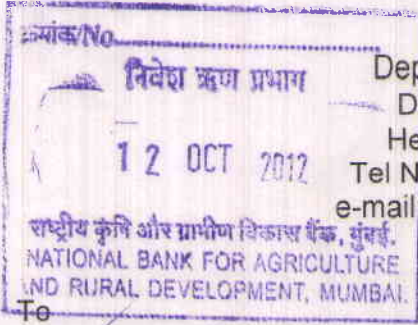

**Sub: Eligibility of Cotton, Ginning, Pressing and Baling Units for subsidy under AMIGS Scheme – reg.**

Sir,

The eligibility of Cotton, Ginning, Pressing and Baling Units for subsidy under AMIGS Scheme has been examined. In supersession of all earlier guidelines/clarifications issued in this matter, it is informed that following activities may be considered eligible / ineligible for subsidy under AMIGS Scheme:


**A. Activities, which are eligible:**

- (i) Units, which make direct purchase of cotton and provides ginning facility to farmers. The pressing and baling facilities may also be there in the project.
- (ii) Units who do not make direct purchase of cotton from the farmers but provide services of cotton ginning to the farmers. The pressing and baling facilities may also be there in the project.

**B. Activities, which are not eligible:**

- (i) Cotton pressing and baling factories which presses the cotton and makes bales and do not have ginning facility. Because, pressing is not the first stage of processing.
