- 3. As a result of rounding off, numbers in tables may not add to totals, and percentages in figures have been adjusted to add to 100.
- 4. Given the phasing of projects, disbursement in any FY may not correspond to sanction for that FY.
- 5. Regions as defined by NABARD:

South: Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, and Lakshadweep

West: Gujarat, Goa, Maharashtra, Dadra & Nagar Haveli, and Daman & Diu
